Hydrilla Treatment

The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) will be treating Lake Istokpoga for hydrilla again this month. It is our understanding that some contact herbicide is being applied in some northern areas of the lake where the hydrilla is topped out as this article is being written.

Aerial spraying is expected to begin about February 8th. Normally the Florodone is applied in pellet form but recent problems with microbes in the soil are forcing DEP to try a different form of application. This year they are applying the herbicide in liquid form. This should allow the herbicide to kill the hydrilla instead of being eaten by the microbes.

After the initial application, the concentration of the herbicide in the water will be monitored to insure a sufficient amount remains in the water column. Additional applications will be based on keeping the concentrations at levels high enough to kill the hydrilla.


